

The policy for the Astronomy classroom is divided into Grading, late work, and safety. Please read all very carefully prior to signing.

Expectations:

BE on time

After the bell you are tardy.

After 5 minutes you are considered absent.

BE prepared

Need to have your book, computer, notebook, paper, & writing utensil

Need to be seated working on your bell ringer prior to bell

BE respectful

Everyone's opinion is valued, do not be rude

Everyone's voice needs to be heard in an orderly manner

Grading:

The assignments will be posted on the internet on my sites and google classroom also you will be receiving a calendar of events. Please understand due to timing, meetings, and unscheduled events the calendar may become off. Compositions notebooks will be taken up on Friday to be graded over the weeks work.

Night labs are considered a summative grade in which you must attend two out of three night labs which cover different material during a nine week period. These will be scheduled for 8:45 at the beginning of the year and will move to an earlier time as the year progresses. We will schedule the same material during a week to two week period based on weather.

Late work:

I will be taking the work up on Fridays with the notebook. If you are going to be absent on Friday **MAKE SURE YOU TURN IT IN** on Thursday. If you are sick and have no way to send it to school, Email me or have a parent/guardian email me. The following is the late work policy at Community High School. If you fail to turn in work on the date it is due the work is considered late. You will have two days to turn in the work for a maximum grade of 70 if it is complete and correct. After the second days it is a zero.

If you are absent you have the number of absent days missed to turn in the missing work and make up missed work. I.e. you missed one day you have one additional day to turn in the work. I will email you if possible the missing work so you can work on it when you are feeling better.

Redo's and Retakes:
